These crimes start with passion gone haywire

Exodus 20:13: "You shall not murder"

What does he mean by "murder"?

Exodus 21:12-32 and 22:2 help explain

Murder is

- Premeditated and intentional

We also see just how precious life is to God.
"Within your nation murder is not allowed"

But then Jesus comes along

Matthew 5:21-25

- bitter anger is like murder
- Calling someone names....
- is like stripping them of their identity
- it's like murder
- **The Antidote-** reconciliation

Because murder begins in the heart.

Exodus 20:14: "You shall not commit adultery"

Adultery- man has sex with married woman-
Not his wife.

The penalty in Deuteronomy is death

Why? Marriage is symbol of God with his people

But then Jesus comes along

Matthew 5:27-30

Adultery begins in the heart.

The Antidote- take serious measures

The ten commandments would remind
the Israelites And us

That we need a savior.
